**RE: Children placed at risk by your social workers**

Attached, please find a copy of a letter I sent by registered mail to your social worker, Mr. Wolfgang Puzstay of Sauble Beach. Unfortunately, I have to send this letter through you as Mr. Puzstay has refused to accept delivery of my letter to him sent by registered mail through Canada Post.

I would therefore ask that your office forward this letter on to him.

Although some of the workers at your agency do try to do their job professionally, unfortunately there are too many who do not. Information about your biased and unaccountable social workers is beginning to spread in the community. People are beginning to find out about the damage being done to many children and families as a result of incompetent work of your social workers.

As far as I am concerned only those with something to hide should be afraid to accept registered mail as your worker, Mr. Wolfgang Puzstay, has done. What is he afraid of? I know that many other parents in this community would share my opinion in this matter.

As I said in my attached letter, it is my intent to launch legal action against the Office of the Children's Lawyer, the Province of Ontario and Mr. Puzstay personally should harm come to my daughter as a result of the court following his flawed and biased recommendations. Between now and when my daughter turns 18 years of age, should harm come to her as a result, I will encourage her to sue for damages suffered when she was younger. Knowing the mother and her family as I do, I am confident that it is only a matter of time until something happens to my daughter.

How your social worker, Mr. Pusztay, can recommend that this abusive mother should have sole custody when there is a documented history of domestic violence, abuse and exposure of my daughter to persons convicted of sexually assaulting children is beyond belief!

What is so bizarre is that your social worker stated that my three-year-old daughter had a "right" to be with this convicted child sexual abuser who my daughter is not even blood related to. This same convicted child sexual abuser is the same person that sexually abused my daughter's mother. And your social worker states in his report that my daughter has the "right" to be with this person. This is SICK and absurd.

Mr. Bruce Rivers of the Metro Toronto Children Aid Society has publicly stated "the best indicator of future child abuse is the past history of child abuse". Evidence shows that my daughter is being abused by her mother Evidence shows that domestic violence and sexual abuse were prevalent in the mother's family for many years. Evidence shows my daughter is exposed to drinking and smoking. Yet your workers place my child in this sort of environment.

Just what the hell is going on with your agency? Have your workers lost their common sense? Is it common for workers with your agency to recommend that three-year-old children be in the care of persons who have a history of domestic violence and convictions of sexual abuse of children and who are currently before the court for domestic violence charges by the police?

Your workers are making a mockery of child protection in this province as well as bringing disgrace to you and to those at your agency who do try to do their jobs with professionalism. You are the boss and must take responsibility for your workers actions.

I would strongly suggest that you start taking a closer look at just what your workers are doing in the field. I have been told by reliable sources that you are on the public record as saying that Ontario's Office of the Children's Lawyer **DOES NOT** represent the best interest of children. Maybe it is time that this policy be changed for the betterment of this province's children.

If you, Mr. McTavish, can't do the job of competently running the affairs of Ontario's Office of the Children's Lawyer, then maybe it time you consider stepping down and letting someone else take over the job who is better able and willing to get the workers back in line at your agency.

Your confirmation of this letter, in writing, would be greatly appreciated.
